


Universal Coordinated Time In 1884, representatives from select countries met at the International Meridian Conference in Washington, D.C. During the conference, the members decided to designate the line of longitude that passes through Greenwich, England, as the Prime Meridian. Each one hour increment represents a time zone. Standard Time Benjamin Franklin came up with a plan to change time on the clock and move it ahead one hour in the summer. Time advances one hour for every 15 degrees east you move from

the Prime Meridian in Greenwich, London. UTC is the time standard. The solution was to divide the country into four time zones: eastern, central, mountain and pacific. Within each region, all the clocks displayed the same time.
